## Call to Prayer for Russia July 2016

The European Evangelical Alliance is extremely concerned about Russia's new anti-terrorism law, passed on 6<sup>th</sup> July, which greatly restricts religious freedom. It is due to come into force on 20 July.

- Sharing one's faith will now be restricted to named members of registered organisations.
- Discussion about faith will only be able to take place in registered religious buildings.
- All sharing of faith will be forbidden in homes. Informal witnessing between individuals is not allowed.
- There are also restrictions on witnessing via social media.
- If the law is broken, the fines to be paid are high.
